Competition rules: Estonian paramotor endurance competition rules 2012

Program: According to the Competition Rules, Notice of Race, weather conditions and decisions of the Competition Director

Competition Classes: PF1, PF2, PL1, PL2

Limitations: Maximum number of competitors is 50 according to the registration order.

Qualification: Minimum 30 hours as Pilot in Command on the class to be flown.

Liability: EACH PILOT TAKES OFF, FLIES AND LANDS ENTIRELY AT HIS/HER OWN RISK.

Insurance: A third party insurance and personal accident insurance for competitors is

highly recommended for all classes.

Mandatory safety equipment: Protective helmet, protective propeller cage.

Recommended safety equipment:

Rescue parachute, supportive boots, protective goggles, gloves.

Mandatory additional equipment:

FR (logger) or GPS with USB cable and software for MS Windows XP or MS Windows 7, mobile phone, watch.

Recommended additional equipment:

Backup FR or GPS, digital camera with memory card, batteries, chargers, stopwatch, compass, map tools, mapboard or map-pocket, radio transceiver, mobile bluetooth, first aid kit, fire extinguisher, drinking water.

Visiting pilots:

Visiting pilots all around the world are welcome to take part and to compete in European Open Paramotor Endurance Championships 2012 contest.

Attention! Competition site is reserved for competitors only on 30 of June and 1 of July. No other flying activities allowed in the area during the competition, except with the permission from the Competition Director.

Non competitive flying is allowed on 29 of June only.

Prizegiving: Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 placed pilots for each validated class and contest. There will be possibly some special prizes given.

- FR (logger) or GPS, USB cable & software if required
- Reserve and other equipment and accessories if required
- Equipment declaration (to be filled on site)
- Liability waiver (must be filled and signed on site)

On registration each competitor will be given official competition map and competition numbers.

Competition numbers should be installed on the wing and on the helmet according to the instructions.
